Fees

Fees are broken into two parts - Baseball Victoria (BV) and Club fees. The BV fees have increased considerably from last season (up by \$58 for adult players, \$35 for juniors and \$13 for Tballers). However the club is pleased to say that we will be absorbing most of these increases by actually dropping the club fees portion. As long as our members continue to support the club by supporting our social events and fundraising activities, bringing on Club Sponsors and supporting the canteen, we will continue to keep fees as low as possible. Our fees continue to be cheaper than many other clubs.

Registration & Payment of Fees - Baseball Victoria

You must register and pay your BV fees before your first game!! There are no exceptions!!! You can't play unless registered/paid this portion. This is a BV imposed rule. We will be checking every player before their first game and if not registered paid you are unable to take the field. Simply, if we play one unregistered player, the game will be forfeited and we incur a fine.

Juniors - Under 12 (Kids born 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015)

We have made some changes to the junior structure for Under 12's which we are basing on the number of new registrations and ages. Players will be split into a Rookie League and a Metro League.

Rookie league will predominantly be 8-9 year olds. They will still play on Sunday mornings and against other clubs but in a modified version. Metro players will also play Sundays but will essentially be playing normal baseball. The age groups are a general guide only and selection in teams will consider ability and experience.
